Do you think 264 visitors brought to church is a significant thing? That is just one of the accomplishments of teenagers participating in the Arizona Youth Challenge over the past two summers. The teens have also memorized over 4,300 Bible verses and

distributed nearly 11,000 gospel tracts.

The Arizona Youth Challenge is a contest among fundamental church youth groups in Arizona this summer. For nine weeks, teenagers will serve the Lord in their own churches and

report to us on their efforts. Points are earned and tabulated with the winner receiving a private retreat at West Branch and a Mountain of Dew!
