After several years of fact-finding missions and engineering work, we have received our permit for sanitation construction! I cannot emphasize enough how big of a milestone this is. Not only does it allow us to now get bids and transfer from estimates to more accurate dollar amounts, but it also triggers several other approvals from the City of Williams concerning water, fire protection, road work, etc.

Please be praying with us as we start the bidding process. We need the right contractor who will work with us. We also need the Lord to provide the money to accomplish the project.

As the "behind-thescenes" work has continued, so has the on-site renovation projects. This month we have taken several steps forward on the bunkhouse project. Volunteers have come from around Arizona to help relocate our kitchen and upgrade the electrical system. Also, all ten camp cabins and our first aid station have been freshly repainted. Some trim work remains. but we have taken a step forward in our battle with the Arizona sun!



As this newsletter goes out, work will be starting on our new basketball/ volleyball court which will have heavy use this summer during our 25th Anniversary Reunion and our two "trial run" camps. Please pray with us that we will have the additional volunteer workers needed to setup our temporary auditorium, complete the bunkhouse, assemble bunk beds, and get everything looking good for our firstever camps on site.
