Summer Camp: God Did It Again!

Heading into summer, we were on a crash course with a hard deadline to complete our projects to have fully operational camp cabins. Somehow, somehow, the Lord helped us accomplish the goal. We certainly had to adjust a few expectations here and there; however, we had cabins with fully usable restrooms. No more shower houses or portable units outside the cabins! God allowed us to have working sanitation, fresh water, propane, and fire protection systems completed since last summer. We finished a huge amount of "touch up" projects in the ten cabins and first aid building. Also, we set up a food storage commissary to support our mobile kitchen. As a bonus, the Lord gave us an extremely important road extension into the center of camp to accommodate water and food delivery and, most importantly, campers arriving for their week of camp!

All of this work was essential to accommodate the campers we had this summer from Arizona, Colorado, and California. During our two weeks of youth and junior camps, we saw eight young people trust Christ as their Savior and many others pray with counselors about important spiritual decisions in their lives.
