One Big Project Accomplished

With the help of a Christian electrical contractor and a number of volunteers, we have been able to expand our electrical capacity on site with a new transformer and switching cabinet to service the future dining hall. Also, thanks to many generous donations, this work is entirely paid for! As an immediate benefit, this work also supported our brand new lights for our basketball court.

This work is just part of a larger goal to build our 10,000 square-foot dining hall. A donor has promised funds for the building if we can raise the money for the infrastructure to support it. So far, we have raised over \$68,000 which paid for the electrical expansion and gives us a start toward the fire protection expansion which includes six additional 25,000-gallon water tanks.
