Dining Hall- Over \$140,000 has been given for infrastructure projects (56% toward the goal - \$250,000). The electrical expansion is complete. Fire suppression permitting is nearly done. Building construction is beginning to be planned.

We are always looking for new ways to carry out our mission. In April, that meant hosting Christian high school seniors for senior trip retreats. Being sixty miles from Grand Canyon, we are an ideal location and ministry to blend a once-in-a-lifetime trip with spiritual impact through daily preaching services. **Schools came from Oregon, North Carolina, and Florida** this year. We already have groups lined up for 2020 as well. This spring will also see the beginning of a Family Seminar ministry as we will travel to four Arizona cities between January and April to hold these events designed to encourage biblical parenting.

Could Construction Start Next Summer?

The dining hall is the next major part of our development plan. Over \$140,000 has been raised toward the infrastructure for the building. A donor is willing to pay for the construction of the building itself. Primarily we have been stalled in need of additional help managing the project. That seems to be coming together, and we are now setting a **goal to begin construction of the building next summer.**



Many details still need to be taken care of and questions answered. We also still need to raise approximately \$110,000 to complete the infrastructure part of the project. Please pray with us that the Lord will provide the funds, answers, timing, and people to get this major project underway!
