Pressing toward the Goal

Building a large building during a time of uncertainty in not exactly a "textbook good decision"! However, when the Lord opens the door, you should go through it. When the offer of a generous \$1,000,000 donation for the building aligned with an available contractor to oversee the project, it was clear that it was time to move forward.

Over the past year, we have been able to put that donation to good use. Even when we were limited with service opportunities, we were able to move forward with development because the money was available. The goal right now is to have a multi-purpose building to use this summer for services, games, and storage. We will transition this into a dining hall eventually.

In December, the Bill Rice Ranch leadership sent out an update letter appealing for additional funds to enable us to get over the hump and complete this phase. Part of the need centers on a \$50,000+ water pump that must be installed to service the new building's fire sprinkler system. The letter stated our goal of \$150,000 to finish this scope of the project. As I write this update, just over \$108,000 of that has come in or been promised! That's an amazing response to a lofty goal. And the timing could not be better. We will need to order this pump within the next couple of weeks to have the chance of getting it installed in time. That is the most time-sensitive part of the project.
