Progress on the Rasmussen Crossing

Back in October 2022, we began the process of appealing to our county for the permit to add the Rasmussen Crossing to the current camp sanitation system. The Crossing is currently being used primarily as an auditorium but has a future purpose of being our kitchen and dining hall as well. While the City of Williams has worked with us to have temporary use of the building, we will not have a permanent occupancy for this auditorium stage until we have functioning bathrooms in the building. Until that is completed, we are required to rent a portable restroom trailer for each summer of use. The rental costs \$4,000+ each summer.

In order to have working bathrooms, there are three aspects of the project to complete: 1) connecting the Crossing to our current sanitation system, 2) adding a water supply, and 3) outfitting the bathrooms. Recently, **Coconino County granted us a permit** to add the entire building even with the future kitchen to the current sanitation system! This is a huge praise because the County told us several years ago that they would *not* permit this, but they changed their minds.

Though we are not ready to do the exterior work due to the lack of funds, we do believe that we can get a reasonable estimate this spring in order to let people know the needs. The installation will include three septic tanks, a pump, and a significant distance of pipe in the ground.

For about a decade, the Bill Rice Bible College has been training young people to serve the Lord. Over the course of time, a number of western teens have gone to train in Tennessee. Most of these young people were first campers or summer staff volunteers at West Branch. We have made it a priority to promote the college because we believe so strongly that young people should be trained to serve the Lord.

This spring we have an even stronger connection to this aspect of the Ranch ministry. Evangelist Troy Carlson is spending the spring semester teaching Bible and ministry classes in Tennessee. Responsibilities also include preaching a number of college chapel services, traveling to preach in several local churches, representing the college with a singing group, holding two revival meetings, and preaching for two youth outreaches.

The Carlsons will return to Arizona in April in time for the men's conference and the senior trip retreats. Additional Ranch staff is now in Arizona to assist our staff with facilities and projects throughout the winter. Please pray for effectiveness and progress at both locations.
