## FAMILY CAMP INFORMATION SHEET

### Basic Information

Family Camp

July 2-4

Camp starts Thursday with check-in from 9:00am-3:00pm and ends with a light breakfast Saturday morning. The first meal served is Thursday supper.

### Getting Registered

#### Fees and Registration:

By June 2: \$110 per person for the first 2 in the family, then \$60 per person after that for all age 5 and up. These fees INCLUDE the \$25 per person registration fee which is sent in advance. Anyone in the family up to age 4 - \$10 per only paid at arrival (no registration fee).

After June 2: \$120 per person for the first 2 in the family, then \$70 per person after that for all age 5 and up. These fees INCLUDE a \$35 per person registration fee. Anyone up to age 4 - still \$10 only, paid at arrival, with no registration fee.

Registration: Send the registration fee for each person in the family age 5 & up with one registration form per family. Registration is \$25 per person by June 2 and \$35 per person after June 2 while space is available. Registration fees are non-refundable. The balance may be paid upon arrival. Please contact us in advance about staying one extra night for \$50 to enjoy local Fourth of July events.

### Camp Policies

**Dress:** From its beginning West Branch has encouraged its guests to honor the Lord in appearance. Wholesome standards displaying modesty and distinction between the sexes are intended to be a help and blessing to you.

Men & Boys age 7+ No shorts. Jeans, sweatpants, and full-length athletic pants are fine at any time.

Ladies & Girls No pants, shorts (see last line), capris or gauchos. Skirts, dresses, and activity attire (culottes/athletic wear) must be knee-length and of proper fullness. We accept knee-length, baggy athletic shorts as culottes.

Both We do ask campers to clean up for the services.

**Cell Phones:** We ask teens and children to not carry cell phones with them at camp. We ask adults to be considerate of camp programs in regards to their phones. Also, cell coverage is spotty at our location.

**Do Not Bring:** Radios, CD/MP3/DVD players, video games, skate boards, bikes, roller blades, knives, or firearms. No smoking. No pets.

**Note:** No West Branch meals or activities are provided after Saturday breakfast. Camp guidelines still apply for those staying Saturday night.

### Helpful Information to Know

**Please Bring:** Bible, notebook, pen, flashlight, bedding/sleeping bag (bunk beds), towels, washcloths, reusable water bottle, good shoes for activities, and other personal items. Standard housing is in a camp cabin with bunk beds. Bedding, towels and washcloths may be rented from West Branch (limited supply). You will need money for snacks, souvenirs, books, CDs, etc. Jackets or sweatshirts are helpful for cool evenings and mornings.

**Medical:** Diabetics or others on special diets must bring their own foodstuffs if supplements beyond the regular meal are desired. A shared refrigerator and microwave are available for use under supervision for those with special dietary needs. Camper insurance will be primary coverage for any accident or illness incurred at camp.
