Basic Information

Camp starts Thursday afternoon and ends after breakfast on Saturday.

Getting Registered

Fees:

Deaf Adults: Registration fee of \$20 + \$100 paid later = \$120 Total

Deaf age 19 and under: COMPLETELY FREE

Hearing Children of Deaf Adults:

- **Ages 6-19** Registration fee of \$20 + \$40 paid later = \$60 Total
- **Ages 2-5** Registration fee of \$20 only = \$20 Total Under age 2 = Free

Registration Card: must be completed with signatures.

Camp Policies

Dress: From its beginning West Branch has encouraged its guests to honor the Lord in appearance. Wholesome standards displaying modesty and distinction between the sexes are intended to be a help and blessing to you.

Boys No shorts. Since all campers are asked to be neat and clean for the services, sweatpants or full-length athletic pants will not be appropriate for services, but rather just for activities. Jeans are fine at any time.

Girls No pants, shorts (see last line), capris, or gauchos. Skirts, dresses, and activity attire (culottes/athletic shorts) must be knee-length and of proper fullness. Skirts or dresses are required for classes and services. Culottes or athletic shorts should only be worn for activities. We accept knee-length, baggy athletic shorts as culottes.

Cell Phones: While campers may bring cell phones with them for use on the trip, those age 19 and under will be required to store them for the entire camp.

Do Not Bring: Radios, CD/MP3/DVD players, video games, skate boards, bikes, roller blades, large knives, or firearms. No smoking. No pets.

Helpful Information to Know

Please Bring: Bible, notebook, pen, flashlight, bedding/sleeping bag (bunk beds), towels, washcloths, reusable water bottle, good shoes for activities, and other personal items. Bedding, towels and washcloths may be rented from West Branch (limited supply). Families may stay together if space permits. Cabins will be assigned based on registration date. Those coming as individuals will stay in men or women's cabins. You will need money for snacks, souvenirs, books, etc. Jackets will be needed.

Medical: All camper medications must be turned in to the camp first aid station and will be dispensed by staff on a regular schedule. Information and instructions for taking medication should be sent on the registration card. Diabetics or others on special diets must bring their own foodstuffs if supplements beyond the regular meal are desired. A shared refrigerator and microwave are available for use under supervision for those with special dietary needs. While the campground is mostly flat and some cabins are handicap accessible, there are no paved sidewalks. Please contact us to ask about your particular situation if you have a difficult time getting around.
